- "She's good at making us quiet"
- "Knows how to get us to help each other"
- "She's funny and I learn better when it's funny"
- "They are very good at Maths"
- "She tells us funny stories"
- "Things always go very quickly in her lessons"

Any Areas Raised As An Issue:

- "Bigger playground!"
- "Even more toys"
- "More time for snacks"
- "More time on computers"
- "When do we get to choose things?"
- "I don't get to finish things when I want"
- "We need more time to think sometimes"
- "I want to use the learn pads more"
- "Sometimes we need to talk about it more"
- "I don't always get to go out with (TA)"

SMSC Related Comments:

- The children are very positive about each other
- They talk readily about opportunities for collaboration
- They knew the purpose and role of the Christian focal point
- They happily access their equipment independently
- The children could talk about the manner / safety rules of the week
- The children cited how they collaborate and support each other
- The children knew how important prayer was
- Children all used to collaboration
- Could explain when and why they pray
